## Notice to Participants/General Information

Competitors, through the submission of their entries, acknowledge that they know the AAC rules and regulations. **All dogs and Junior Handlers must have an AAC ID Number that must be on the entry forms.** Note: AAC regulations require the handler to obtain an ID card directly from the AAC. If you do not have an AAC ID card for your dog or Junior Handler, please submit the appropriate AAC application form at the end of this premium list directly to the AAC. Please note that it takes several weeks to get an AAC ID card. A valid AAC ID card must be presented at the trial check-in, otherwise the dog must be measured for verification of jump height and/or a Junior Handler would not be permitted to compete at this trial.

**Title Trial:** Dogs will be divided into four (4) height categories in each of the three (3) class levels.

Masters Class is open to dogs that have an AADC Title

Masters Games are open to dogs that have three corresponding Advanced Games legs

Advanced Class is open to dogs that have an ADC Title

Advanced Games are open to dogs that have two corresponding Starters Game legs

Starters Class is open to dogs that have not earned an ADC Title

Starters Games are open to dogs that have not earned two legs in that Starters Game

Competitors may enter one level down from where they would normally be entitled to compete, are eligible to earn Qs and placements only if the appropriate level is not offered.

Please Note: It is the responsibility of the Handler to inform The Agility Connection organizing committee if requirements for a Title have been met.

**Award of Merit Trial:** Junior Handlers will be divided into three (3) levels of classes.

Masters Level is open to Junior Handlers that have received a JH Award of Merit - Advanced Level

Advanced Level is open to Junior Handlers that have received a JH Award of Merit - Starters Level

Starters Level is open to Junior Handlers that have not received a JH Award of Merit - Starters Level

Competitors may enter one level down from where they would normally be entitled to compete, are eligible to earn Qs and placements only if the appropriate level is not offered.

Please Note: It is the responsibility of the Handler to inform The Agility Connection organizing committee if requirements for a Junior Handler Award of Merit have been met.

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, or in the event of inclement weather.

Refunds will be issued for dogs that come into heat, or are injured, providing the Trial Secretary receives a veterinarian's certificate at least 48 hours before the start of the trial. All entries must be "received by" or "postmarked by" the closing date.

**Move Ups** will be permitted providing the Trial Secretary is informed by writing at least five (5) days prior to this event. No move-ups shall be permitted during this trial.

**Confirmations** will be posted to the web ([www.theagilityconnection.net](http://www.theagilityconnection.net)) as registrations are received. Cheques may be deposited once the competitor's confirmation has been posted to the web.

**Obstacles:** All obstacles conform to AAC specifications and may include - A-Frame, Dog Walk, Teeter, Weave Poles, Table, Flexible Tunnels, Collapsible Tunnel (Chute), Tire Jump, Ascending Spread Jump, Double Bar Jump, Single Bar Jumps and Wing Jumps.

**Facilities:**

- \* This is an outdoor event that will proceed rain or shine.
- \* Events will alternate between Ring One and Ring Two.
- \* Each ring measures 110 ft. by 110 ft. and both rings are a grass surface.

**Awards:**

- \* Rosettes, ribbons, awards and prizes will be presented between events as time permits.
- \* Certificates and/or seals will be awarded to all dogs receiving Expert Titles
- \* Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving Awards of Merit and Lifetime Awards of Excellence.
- \* Dogs receiving their Agility Trial Champion of Canada (ATChC) will be recognized with a TAC award.
- \* Title Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs and/or Junior Handlers receiving a Title and/or Award of Merit.
- \* Qualifying Rosettes will be awarded for achieving an AAC qualifying score
- \* Placement Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place will be awarded for each level and class.  
Open and Mini Divisions may be combined for placement depending on the number of entries received.

**Super Q:**

- \* Super Q Rosettes will be presented to Dog and Handler Teams in Gamblers and Snooker at every Level.
- \* Snooker Super Q Rosettes will be awarded to dogs achieving at least 52 points.
- \* Gamblers Super Q Rosettes will be awarded to dogs based on the number requirement determined by the Judge to be exceptional, based on the Gamblers Event being judged and announced the day of the trial.

**Dogs:**

- \* All dogs must be kept in an x-pen, crate or on leash when not in the ring.
- \* Handlers are responsible to keep their dogs quiet at all times except when they are running in an event.
- \* Handlers are responsible to clean up after their dogs.
- \* Any dog engaging in aggressive behaviour at any time will be required to leave the trial grounds. There will be no refund of fees in such instances.
- \* Any handler displaying inhumane or aggressive treatment of any dog, physically or verbally, while on site, will be asked to leave the trial grounds. There will be no refund of fees in such instances.

- \* Vendors, including a food vendor, will be available.
- \* Water will be available for cooling dogs.
- \* Competitors are responsible for their own shade, seating and crating.
